What is a CEU?

Learners may receive recognition for their efforts to broaden their knowledge and skills by documenting their noncredit learning experiences with CEUs.

One CEU is defined as 10 contact hours.

CEUs may be applied to appropriate noncredit offerings designed to meet the following outcomes:

1. To maintain and/or improve professional competence.
2. To document qualifications for renewing licensure, recertification or registration.
3. To present evidence of personal and vocational growth.
4. To prepare for a new career.

Learners in CMC continuing education offerings may request verification of CEUs to confirm attendance and completion. Some learners in particular professions may be required by accrediting organizations to attain CEUs to maintain professional standing in their field. CMC makes no claims as to whether CMC CEUs will apply toward such accreditation. It is the responsibility of the learners to confirm such application with their respective accrediting bodies.

What Do I Need to Do?

In order for Colorado Mountain College to process CEUs, each participant requesting CEUs must complete the CMC noncredit registration form on the back of the scheduling form available at the RMLA Registration Desk.

Turn this completed form into the Registration Desk at the end of the conference. Make sure the names match on both sides of the form and they are legible. Make sure you have the required stickers attached to the scheduling side.
